Thank you for the information regarding the paper that you are presenting. I have spoken to members of the Executive of the NSW Branch of the Australian SAS Association and we have no hesitation in unanimously endorsing the views that you have made in this paper.

Two specific points of view that persuaded us to endorse this is the Common Law aspect being the same as the Injury Adjustment and the fact that there is such a difference in the Threshold payments across Australia. The fact that a member of the ADF is injured in one State and is liable to receive a greater (or lesser) payment than others residing in a different State is in our opinion completely unjust and goes against the "Beneficial Intent" of the legislation.
