



Jurisdictional Policy Advice No. 2007/06
Safety, Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 1988
AWOTEFA update under sub-section 19(5) – effective 17 May 2007

Background

1. Sub-section 19(5) of the *Safety, Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 1988* (SRC Act) provides for a ceiling on weekly incapacity payments determined under subsection 19(3) (normally after the first 45 weeks) of 150% of the ***Average Weekly Ordinary Time Earnings for Full Time Adults*** (AWOTEFA), as published by the Australian Statistician.
2. The latest figure (February Quarter 2007) was published by the Australian Bureau of Statistics on 17 May 2007 at an amount of \$1070.40.

Policy Advice

3. The relevant figure for the purposes of calculation of entitlements under sub-section 19(5) of the SRC Act is **\$1605.60** being 150% of AWOTEFA.
4. The date of effect for this increase is 17 May 2007.
5. The next figure is expected to be released on 16 August 2007.
