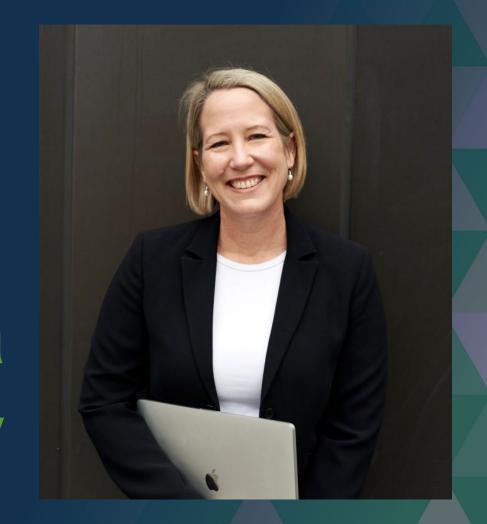

Why emotions and trust must come first

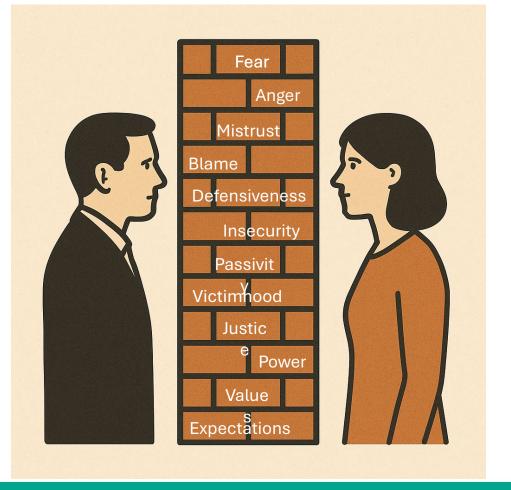
Sophie is returning from stress leave. She and her manager, Mark, sit down to **plan reduced hours and duties**.

- Sophie fears she'll be overloaded again and pushes for minimal responsibilities.
- Mark feels defensive and insists she "step up" to cover workload gaps.
- The conversation quickly stalls as mistrust and resentment bubble up.



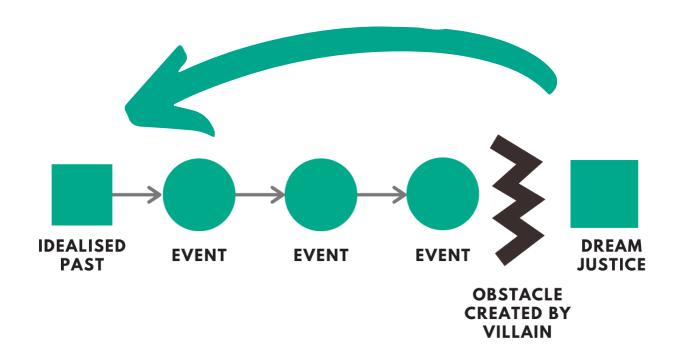




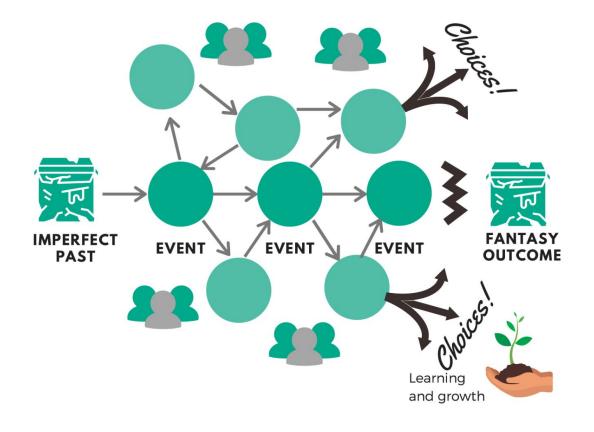

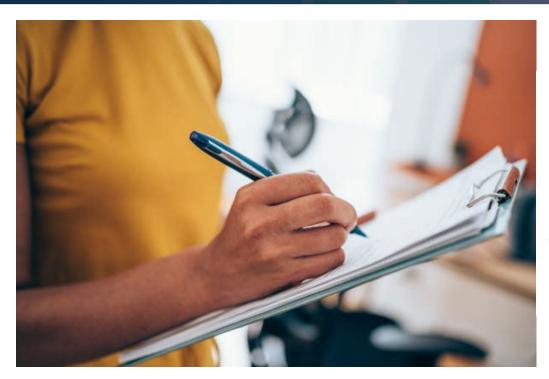
