# Privacy statement

As part of Comcare's Psychosocial Inspection Program, workers may be invited to complete a Comcare survey.

Participation in this survey is voluntary, and you do not need to provide your personal information to complete the survey. If you choose to provide your personal information, Comcare may contact you in future with a relevant follow-up survey. Any personal information collected will be handled in accordance with the *Privacy Act 1988*. Please do not include personal information about anyone else in your response.

Comcare is authorised to collect personal information relevant to its functions under the *Work Health and Safety Act 2011*. The information you provide will be used for the purposes of Comcare's Psychosocial Inspection Program, which includes seeking your feedback about your employer's psychosocial safety practices, and to assist Comcare with its assessment of your employer's compliance with its WHS obligations.

No personal information obtained from your response will be shared with your employer. Group level de-identified themes will be shared in aggregate with your employer to inform them of areas of improvement. Some de-identified/anonymous quotes may also be shared. Your de-identified response may also be shared with third parties contracted by Comcare to assist with research and analysis. Comcare is unlikely to disclose your personal information overseas.
